



4.1 Input / output channel key operation


Channel	Button method	
Any Key	The first operation of the button can wake up the screen	
Input 1-4	Directly press the number key, such as input channel 1, and select "1" to press (only when the output port is selected, the input channel number will be valid)	
Output 1-4	Directly press the number key, such as the output channel 3, select the key "3" and press it again to cancel the selection;Long press output channel 4 to select all channels, and long press again to cancel	
MENU	Function Button; Enter the function option or back to previous option	
ENTER	Confirm Button: enter function selection mode	
UP	Button for UP option	
DOWN	Button for NEXT option	
MUTE	Shut down the current selected output, press again to wake up	
LOCK	Long press lock (button built-in blue light on), Long press again to cancel lock (button built-in blue light off)	

4.2 Video switching operation

4.2.1 Video switch

The signal switch includes 4 free switching channels, which can be configured as input/output according to the requirements, forming a matrix of 1 x $4 \sim 4$ x 1, which can switch any input. Signal to 1 channel output or all channel output.

The specific operation is as follows:



Video switching mode (P1)

Switch the input to the output

Operation format: "output channel" + "input channel"

For Example: Output port 2,3,4 switch to input 2

Operation: Press OUT number "2" "3" "4" + IN number "2" to complete the switch

4.2.2 Video Control

The video interface have two sub menu

- 1. Video Switch
- 2. Video On/Off

The specific operation is as follows:

1. Video Switch

Switch any output to one input or all outputs to the same input

- ①Select"Video"in the menu and press"ENTER"
- ②Then use "UP""DOWN"button to select"Switching"
- ③Press"ENTER"enter next page
- ④Press "UP""DOWN"button to select the output (The fifth port means ALL)
- ⑤Press"ENTER"
- @Press "UP""DOWN"to select the input

Video Switch (P2)

2. Video On/Off

Turn on/off any output video or all outputs video

- ①Select"Video"in the menu and press"ENTER"

- ⑤Press"ENTER"

4.2.3 Audio Control

The Audio Control have two sub menu

- 1. Audio Embed
- 2. Audio De-Embed

The specific operation is as follows:

1.Audio Embed

Audio Embed is for setting input ports audio, it have: Analog; HDMI; Mute setting.

- ①Select"Audio"in the menu and press"ENTER"
- ②Then use "UP""DOWN"button to select"Embed"
- ③Press"ENTER"enter next page
- $\textcircled{4}\mbox{Press}$ "UP""DOWN"button to select the output (The "In 5" means ALL)
- ⑤Press"ENTER"
- ⑥Press "UP""DOWN"to select the mode: Analog; HDMI; Mute
- ⑦Press"ENTER", Done

Audio Embed mode (P4)

2. Audio De-Embed

In the mode of Audio De-Embed has Analog and SPDIF in each output port and can switch the audio Mute and Unmute

- ①Select"Audio"in the menu and press"ENTER"
- ②Then use "UP""DOWN"button to select"De-Embed"
- ③Press"ENTER"enter next page
- $\textcircled{4}\mbox{Press "UP""DOWN"button to select the output (The "Out 5" port means ALL)$
- ⑤Press"ENTER"
- @Press "UP""DOWN"to select the mode of Analog and SPDIF audio format
- ⑦Press"ENTER", confirm
- ®Press"Mute"or"Unmute"to switch the audio

SETUP mode can set the device's RS-232 baud rate, DHCP, Reboot, Factory Specific operations are as follows

1. RS-232 Baud Rate setting

It has 7 kinds of baud rates inside the device: 2400; 4400; 9600; 19200; 34400; 57600; 115200 Default Baud Rate is: 115200

- ①Select"Setup"in the menu and press"ENTER"
- ②Then use "UP""DOWN"button to select the "BAUD"and press "ENTER"
- ③Press "UP""DOWN"button to select the baud rate and press "ENTER"to confirm

BAUD RATE setting (P7)

2. DHCP On/Off setting

On means Dynamic; Off means Static

- ①Select"Setup"in the menu and press"ENTER"
- ②Then use "UP""DOWN"button to select the "DHCP"and press "ENTER"
- ③Press "UP""DOWN"button to select"On"or"Off"and press "ENTER"to confirm

3. Reboot setting



- ⑥ PTP button: Mirror all inputs and outputs



7. IR system

The matrix can pass the IR signal through the IR system to the HDMI source or pass the IR signal from the HDMI source to the HDMI sink




Dual way IR using:

Step1: "IR IN" is for HDBaseT output, "IR OUT" is for input channel

Step2: "IR IN ALL" Controlled by all input IR; "IR OUT ALL" Controlled by all output IR.

Step3: HDBaseT receiver support connect with IR receiver to control the Matrix by remote

Step4: Matrix IR channel "IR IN ALL" support connect with IR-RX cable to control the Matrix by remote



8. Command Control


Control software operation:

The serial control software is illustrated with SSCOM32 as an example. Basic Settings:



Double-click the software in the installation package to run specifically (as shown in figure 1 below) and install the RS232 software on the computer.

Enter the main interface of the software, as shown in the figure below.



In the parameter configuration area, the serial number of serial port and PC connection is selected, and the baud rate of the communication protocol is completed: 115200 (default), data location: 8. Stop bit: 1, check bit: no, you can input the instruction in the command input area and control the machine or remote receiver.

Instructions:

- 1. All commands start from "#", command head "%c": "d" parameters, "l" lock, "s" save.
- 2. The "" in the commands cannot omit. Parameter: %d: 0 means ALL.
- 3. Command head & Parameter1 & Parameter2... need to add one "SPACE".

The following table is only an example. Please refer to the list of instructions.



9. PC Tool Control

- 1. Download the 4x8 HDMI2.0 Matrix_32 to your computer, then open it.
- 2. Using USB to RS232 cable connect to the Matrix
- 3. Press "Search" button to find out the right port then "Open Port"

"LINK" interface description:


- 1. Communication parameters: RS232 port baud rate and port information can be displayed. Click the drop-down queue to set the port and baud rate from 2400 to 115200
- 2. Port setting: Search RS232 Port: "Open Port" is a compound switch Port. When showing "Open Port" means Disconnect. When showing "Close Port: Connecting
- 3. Refresh button: "Search"
- 4. Send instruction bar: the corresponding instruction can be sent according to the command list.
- 5. Instruction feedback display bar: print the log after sending corresponding commands, and operate the equipment to print as well



"LINK" interface (P12)

"VIDEO" interface description:

- 1. Output option bar: 0d>>0x represents display of current device port info.
 0d: 1~4 input ports, 0x: 1~4 output ports, all means all selection, support multiple selection, single selection
- 2. Input options: 01~04 means input port 1~4
- 3. Application Preset: 8 application preset are supported, save: 8 different application scenarios can be saved, and recall: call any one of them
- 4. Rename: HDMI, HDBT, input and other port names can be modified. A total of 4 names are supported for each port. Mouse over one of the output options displays the HDMI and HDBT names, and mouse over one of the input options displays the input name.




Video switch interface (P13)

Usage:

- 1. Video switch: select any of the output options and then click any of the input options to switch directly, for example: click 04>>01 and select 01. The output 1 TV will display the input 1 source
- 2. Application Preset: users can switch and save in the application preset according to the commonly used video, and there is no need to switch the scenes for direct invocation next time. For example, after clicking all, select 04; after clicking perset1, click the red box again to save; after clicking perset1, select the green box recall to call

"AUDIO" interface description:


- 1. Input audio option bar: HDMI audio input and analog audio input can be selected; H represents the audio of HDMI itself; A represents the mixing of analog audio
- 2. Output audio option bar: select analog audio separation, spdif audio separation, A represents analog audio separation, S represents digital audio separation
- 3. The blue background is selected, and gray indicates mute. It can be set with single, multiple or all options



Audio switch interface (P14)

"EDID" interface description:

- 1. Input option bar: 01>>01 is the port status, for example: 01>>01; 01> means the first HDMI port EDID, and >01 means the input port, which means the first HDMI port EDID is copied to the first signal source (in HDMI mode).
- 2.EDID option bar: four modes can be selected in the Output Mode drop-down box, User EDID (editable), built-in Default EDID, Output port HDMI EDID, Output port HDBT EDID



3.EDID display bar: displays the currently set EDID information

EDID interface (P15)

Usage:

1. Copy EDID:

Select the corresponding Input port in the Input (multiple options are available, you need to select All and click the All button)


Select the Output port is HDMI (Default/User/HDBT) in the Output Mode drop-down box. Select the corresponding Output port in the Output to complete the operation

2. The user to edit EDID

Description: copy the Output EDID(currently only supports HDMI and HDBT) to the user-defined EDID(User Mode in Output Mode)

Specific steps: click Edit in the lower right corner of the Output dialog box, and the EDID Edit Page dialog box pops up. Select the corresponding User mode port in the User Option area (multiple options are available). In the Save Option area, select any HDBT or HDMI Output port (single Option) to copy the Output port information to the selected User port.

- 3.Click Exit or X to Exit the interface
- 4. Default EDID: 01-04 EDID can be selected after clicking default




EDID Edit Page (P16)

"Network" interface description:

- 1. Network INFO: MAC address can only be displayed and cannot be modified
- 2.DHCP off state: when using static IP, IP and other addresses can be modified. After apply is applied, it needs to log in the GUI interface again and use the new IP address 2.DHCP are state and the lower with the pulce.
- 3.DHCP on state: use the key switch to switch to DHCP on state, use dynamic IP, IP and other addresses below, and the dialog box turns gray.

Can not be modified, can display the current IP address information


4. DHCP switch is a compound switch, and DHCP On and DHCP Off are two choices. When Off is displayed, it means the current state is static; when On is displayed, it means the current state is dynamic



Network interface(P17)

"System" interface description:

- 1.Product Model:(can be modified)
- 2. Firmware: software version (that cannot be modified)
- 3. Product type: original product type (cannot be modified)
- 4. Reboot: reboot the device
- 5. Factory: restore factory Settings
- 6. Operation steps: click reboot (factory) and the dialog box system restart (default setting) will pop up. Click OK





10.1 Change the IP address of your PC.

- 1). Connect the Ethernet port of matrix to the Ethernet port on PC by a crossover cable with RJ45 connectors.
- 2). Configure your PC as follows:
- ① Click Start > Control Panel > Network and Sharing Center.
- (2) Click Change Adapter Settings.
- (3) Highlight the network adapter you want to use to connect to the device and click **Change settings of this connection**.
- 3). The local Area commotion properties window for Network selection appears as below:
- 4). Click the Highlight Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4).
- 5). Click **Properties**.
- 6). Select **Use the following IP Address** for static IP addressing and fill in the details. For TCP/IPv4 you can use any IP address in the range 192.168.1.1 to 192.168.1.255 (excluding 192.168.1.168).
- 7). Click **OK**.
- 4). Click Close.

- (1.Matrix has 5 default accounts: admin~admin4, password: 123456. Account has level permissions
- 2. Only supports changing 6-15 characters of the account password in the form of letters, underscores and Numbers.)

11.RS232 Pass through

By RS232 Command, the matrix can send RS232 data to control the receiver ,also the receiver can send RS232 data to control the Matrix.

Please refer to the command list which included in the manual.

12. RS232 Online upgrading Firmware

- 1. Use serial port upgrade, and the host dial code is pre- adjusted to the right to enter the serial port upgrade mode;
- 2.RS232/Micro USB connection computer and product, open special upgrade software, click "Refresh" to make serial number Refresh;
- 3.COM port to choose the port connected with the product;
- 4. The baud rate setting is consistent with the host baud rate (default 115200);
- 5. Upgrade instructions in the upgrade instruction box (some instructions are as follows);

A1 means MCU;


A1 01 means GUI;


F0 01 means HTML.

- 6. Click on the "..."Select the upgrade file for download;
- 7. Click "Update" and the system starts to upgrade;
- 4. The updated information box will prompt "Succeed" information when the upgrade is completed, and the representative program has been upgraded successfully.

Note:Before burning, it is confirmed that HDMI/HDBT input and export are suspended.If other devices are connected, the host will automatically stop the upgrade.

If the upgrade progress bar is stopped in the middle of the upgrade, then the host will need to be rebooted, then the serial port will be upgraded.





Note: Need an adapter for Phoenix terminal to RS232 port.


